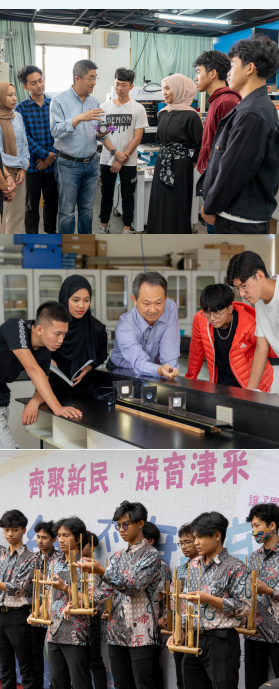
國際專修部



- Students receive assistance in visa application from TETO (Language proficiency is not required).
- Students will enroll to a dedicated Chinese courses for least 720 hours of 1st-year. (About 20 hours/per week)
- Students are required to provide a bank statement showing a minimum balance of US\$3,000.
- Students are eligible to apply for Work Permits. (Max. of 20 hours per week).

Chinese Courses (One Year) 華語先修課程 (1年)

- **Time:** 2026 Fall Admission, 2 Semesters (September 2026~August 2027)
- **Application requirement:** Graduated from High School
- **Application Deadline:** Middle of May, 2026
- **Fees:**
Tuition Fee: NTD\$27,000 Per semester
Dormitory Fee: NTD \$15,000~17,000/per semester (Original price)
Insurance Fee: NTD \$3,000/First semester, NTD\$4,956/ Second semester
- **Scholarships:**
There is no scholarship in 1st-year Chinese courses semesters, but CSU will assist in matching part-time jobs.
Dormitory Fee will be waived for applicants with outstanding academic performance.



Professional Courses (4 Year Bachelor Degree) 專業課程 (4 年制學士班)

- After one year Chinese program, students must pass the A2 of the TOCFL then continue to study professional courses (**Mechanical Engineering or Electronic Engineering**).
- Student must choose a major program before admission to Department of International Foundation Program.
- **Fees:**
Tuition Fee: NTD \$54,735 /per semester
Dormitory Fee: NTD \$15,000~17,000 /per semester (Original price)
National Health Insurance Fee: NTD \$4,956 / per 6 months
- **Scholarships:**
NTD\$ 3,500 per month (If there is no violation of school regulations, students can continue to apply for scholarship up to 4 years; There is no scholarship, if there is an off-campus internship for the whole semester.)
Dormitory Fee will be waived for applicants with outstanding academic performance.
